BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre:

WHEREAS, the Downtown Wilkes-Barre Business Improvement District ("DWBBID") was initially created in 2007, following the requirements of Pennsylvania law, to allow property owners to pool their resources to effectively address common concerns within Downtown Wilkes-Barre; and

WHEREAS, the DWBBID was reauthorized in 2012 by Wilkes-Barre City Council for a term extending to December 31, 2018, with provisions for renewal; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of Pennsylvania law, the Diamond City Partnership developed a Preliminary Plan for the renewal of the DWBBID for a ten-year term beginning on January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, that Preliminary Plan was previously sent to all benefited DWBBID property owners; and

WHEREAS, the Diamond City Partnership held two ratepayer meetings, on October 3 and October 4, 2018, to receive comment from benefited DWBBID property owners regarding the Preliminary Plan; and

WHEREAS, City Council convened a public hearing on October 16, 2018 for the purposes of receiving public comment from benefited DWBBID property owners regarding the Preliminary Plan; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, a Final Plan for the renewal of the DWBBID is being prepared and presented, via US Mail, to all benefited DWBBID property owners; and

WHEREAS, state law dictates that, following the public hearing and the subsequent presentation of the Final Plan, benefiting property owners within the DWBBID shall have 45 days from the presentation of the Final Plan to disapprove the Final Plan by filing objections with the City Clerk following the procedures outlined in the Final Plan:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre hereby initiates a 45-day comment period, commencing at 9:00 AM on October 19, 2018, and ending at 4:00 PM on December 3, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre directs the City Clerk to record and tally all written objections received during the 45-day period from benefited DWBBID property owners, pursuant to the requirements outlined in the Final Plan.
