RESOLUTIONS:

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, declaring that it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the people of the City of Wilkes-Barre to have certain projects to be undertaken by Wilkes University, a Pennsylvania Non-Profit Educational Institution, provided by and financed through the City of Wilkes-Barre Finance Authority. The Authority has heretofore approved the issuance of one or more series of the Authority's revenue bonds in an original aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 (the "2019 Bonds").

Authorizing the proper city officials to complete and submit the application for the City's Fiscal, Operational, and Mission Management 5-Year Plan (Phase IV).

Authorizing the proper city officials to sign any and all necessary documents related to awarding the contract to the lowest responsible bidder for the demolition of 260 Parrish Street.
