**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-27 OF ARTICLE II. OF
CHAPTER 12 OF THE WILKES-BARRE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES
ENTITLED "GARBAGE AND REFUSE."**

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the City Council to pass legislation within the City of Wilkes-Barre by amending Section 12-27 of Article II. of Chapter 12 of the Wilkes-Barre Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE THAT SECTION 12-27 OF ARTICLE II. OF CHAPTER 12 ENTITLED "GARBAGE AND REFUSE" IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

CHAPTER 12. GARBAGE AND REFUSE

ARTICLE II. LITTER AND DISPOSAL

Sec. 12-27. Fee for recyclable newsprint, commingled recyclable aluminum cans and recyclable ferrous containers.

The annual fee for collection of recyclable newsprint, commingled recyclable aluminum cans and recyclable ferrous containers shall be sixty dollars (\$60.00).

SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby. It is the intention of the Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid part not been included.

REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed. All ordinances not specifically amended hereby remain in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE

ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF AN ALLEY KNOWN AS CORBETT LANE IN THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that:

SECTION I. VACATION OF PORTION OF CORBETT LANE. The following portion of an alley known as Corbett Lane located in the City of Wilkes-Barre is hereby vacated and discontinued as an alley:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT “A”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the land of the alley thus vacated and discontinued revert to and vest into the CROSS VALLEY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION (or its designee), as the adjoining property owner as fully to all intents and purposes as though the City of Wilkes-Barre had by formal conveyance duly conveyed the same to said CROSS VALLEY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION (or its designee).

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby. It is the intention of the Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid part not been included.

SECTION III. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

EXHIBIT "A"

PORTION OF CORBETT LANE
TO BE VACATED

ALL that certain piece or parcel of land situated in the City of Wilkes-Barre, County of Luzerne and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at the point intersection of the westerly right of way of Pine Street (48' wide) and the northerly right of way of Corbett Lane (12' wide),

Thence along said right of way the following two (2) courses and distances:

1. South 68°44'10" West one hundred four (104.00') feet to a point,
2. South 53°01'10" West forty-four and nine hundredths (44.09') feet to the westerly terminus of Corbett Lane,

Thence along said terminus, South 16°01'50" East twelve and eighty-five hundredths (12.85') feet to a point on the southerly right of way of Corbett Lane,

Thence along said right of way the following two (2) courses and distances:

1. North 53°01'10" East forty-seven and three hundredths (47.03') feet to a point,
2. North 68°44'10" East one hundred two and thirty-four hundredths (102.34') feet to the westerly right of way of Pine Street,

Thence along said Right of Way North 21°15'50" West twelve (12.00') feet to the point of **BEGINNING**.

CONTAINING 1,785 Square Feet of land being the same, more or less.
