The within temporary suspension applies only to wine tasting by potential customers and not to the general consumption of alcohol. It also only applies to the above-referenced event and area.

Temporarily suspending Section 20-04 of the Wilkes-Barre Code of Ordinances pertaining to the open consumption of alcoholic beverages for the Old Fashioned Holiday Market to be held on November 28, 2020. 

WHEREAS, by Resolution R0007-19 dated January 10, 2019, the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre authorized the proper city officials to sign any and all necessary documents related finalizing a \$350,000.00 grant under the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Act 101 Section 902 program for the purchase of new curbside residential recycling containers and a new leaf vacuum machine.
