AN ORDINANCE

OF THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER FOR THE ENGINEERING, REPAIR, UPKEEP AND MAINTENANCE OF DIVISION STREET AND BRIDGE SITUATE IN AND CROSSING THE BORDER OF BOTH MUNICIPALITIES.

WHEREAS, the Township of Hanover (hereinafter "Township") and the City of Wilkes-Barre (hereinafter, "City") desire and intend to enter an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement for the engineering, repair, upkeep and maintenance of Division Street and, in conjunction therewith, the Division Street Bridge, together with the costs associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the Township and City to divide equally the costs of engineering; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the Township and the City similarly reach a cooperative agreement regarding the repair, upkeep and maintenance thereof by separate Operation and Maintenance (O & M) Agreement.

- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre, as follows:
- **THAT,** an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between the Township and City is hereby authorized for the purposes herein described; and
- THAT, the Township agrees to be responsible for one half of the one hundred sixty-nine thousand dollars (\$169,000.00) in total engineering costs of the Township Engineer for the work herein described which share is currently estimated at eighty-four thousand five hundred dollars (\$84,500.00) contingent upon the City's agreement to pay the complementary half of said costs; and
- **THAT,** the Township and City agree to divide equally, whether by labor or finance, the remaining responsibility of repair, upkeep and maintenance of Division Street and Bridge which agreement shall be more fully set forth by separate Operation and Maintenance Agreement; and
- **THAT,** a copy of this Ordinance shall remain on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and

SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any part of this ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the validity of the remaining provisions shall be unaffected thereby. It is the intention of the Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid part not been included.

REPEALER.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. All ordinances not specifically amended hereby remain in full force and effect.
