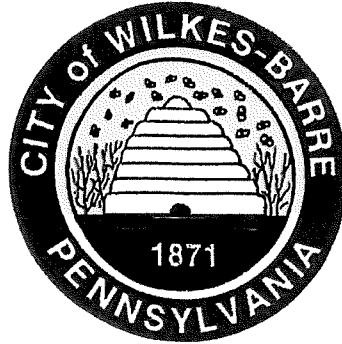

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre:

WHEREAS, the City of Wilkes-Barre wishes to establish, create, organize, and operate a Land Bank, to be known as the Lower South Valley Land Bank, with seven (7) other local entities (Ashley Borough, Hanover Township, Nanticoke City, Newport Township, Plymouth Borough, Plymouth Township, and the Greater Nanticoke Area School District);

WHEREAS, the entities believe the establishment of the Land Bank will serve to create stronger communities by having an entity to deal with blighted, vacant, abandoned, or tax delinquent properties within their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Land Banks Act, it is necessary that the City appoint an Initial Board Member and a member to serve on the Board of Directors of the Land Bank;
