The low bid for specified repairs is \$765,387.50. The project will be funded using the American Recovery Act Money.

The equipment will be purchased from Medico Industries through the DGS Co Stars Program Contract #4400019956. The lease agreement will be funded by the City's Liquid Fuels Budget.
