BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre:
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE DESIGNATING THE GRANT COORDINATOR AS THE AUTHORIZED SIGNATORY FOR EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS, NOTICES AND CONTRACTS AND MANAGEMENT OF PROJECTS THROUGH PENNDOT'S REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT SYSTEM (RAS).
WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has implemented and requires the use of the of its Reimbursement Agreement System (RAS) via the Electronic Contract Management System (ECMS) for all agreements; and
WHEREAS, the City of Wilkes-Barre currently is party to such agreements and anticipates continued participation in such agreements as owner of bridges throughout Wilkes-Barre; and
WHEREAS, all statement of interest, bid, notifications, awards, contracts and agreements to be entered and authorized electronically in the RAS via ECMS with no signature line but rather only an electronic acknowledgement of acceptance; and
WHEREAS, there will be no physical agreements and documents presented before the City Council for execution; and
WHEREAS, all notifications, selections, awards, agreements, and contract executions requiring approval by City Council will be presented as a motion to be approved during a regular public meeting; and
WHEREAS, upon such motion and approval by the City Council, as noted by the duly recorded minutes; any requirements of the City Charter or Administrative Code relating to City Council's role in City contracts will be met; and
WHEREAS, City Council desires to authorize the City Grant Coordinator to execute all paperwork upon such approval;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre as follows:

Upon motion and approval by the City Council of the City of Wilkes-Barre of any action or expenditure pertaining to the management of Wilkes-Barre City's bridges, the Grant Coordinator, Mark Barry, is authorized to approve, as the City's agent, any and all notices, awards and contracts the City must undertake as owner of City bridges through PennDOT's RAS system via the PennDOT's ECMS system. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to attest to the signatures of the City Grant Coordinator.

The (South St. to Hazle St.) portions of the project will include the following improvements: new concrete sidewalks, curbs, sidewalk connections, crosswalks & paving of the street. Also, ADA accessibility improvements such as curb cuts & sidewalk detectable warning surfaces for the new ADA ramps will be replaced. In addition, new street lighting, benches, bicycle racks, & garbage receptacles will be installed along with trees planted to improve the overall quality of the city district. The (Hazle St. to Hanover St.) portion of the project improvements will include milling & paving of the roadway & ADA ramps only.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate George C. Brown, Mayor, and Darren, Snyder, City Controller, as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between the City of Wilkes-Barre and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant along with any or all project documents if the application is approved.
