This project redevelops an abandoned property in the city commonly known as the Murray Complex. Additionally, this grant amount will be leveraged with other project funding. The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) has committed to providing 96.775% of the project funding and this LSA request will provide the remaining 3.225% of the project funding. The total cost of the entire project is \$45,000,000.00; AND

The facility renovation plan includes the creation of 6,000 square feet of men's, women's and universal locker room space; a whirlpool, steam room and sauna; and a massage and lounge area, allowing for improved accessibility and movement throughout the facility; AND

Medical marijuana is a burgeoning local industry, and it is expected that recreational use will be legalized in the near future. The initiation of a Cannabis Certificate Program at Wilkes University will benefit a number of stakeholders including the university, the City of Wilkes-Barre and its residents, and the local and regional economies. The program alone will create three jobs at Wilkes University, and it is expected that after recreational legalization, as many as 250 jobs may move to the region with just one company alone. Establishing this program with the state-of the-art equipment, such as a mass spectrometer and CO2 Extractor, will provide our students with the advanced skills necessary to fill these jobs. Further, our faculty and students will also utilize the equipment to perform research that can inform the basic science of cannabis and advance local economic efforts; AND

Wilkes-Barre City Hall, Fire Headquarters, Police Station and the Health Department are all located in the flood zone due to its proximity to the Susquehanna River. Therefore, in the event of a disaster, particularly flooding, the city must move all of its operations out of the flood zone. The proposed Emergency Operations Center will be an addition to the Hollenback Fire Station, which is located out of the flood zone, and will allow the city to continue operations during disaster events; AND
