CITY OF WILKES-BARRE HOMEOWNERS EMERGENCY REHABILITATION GRANT PROGRAM

As a City of Wilkes-Barre homeowner, you may be eligible for financial assistance to make necessary repairs to your home. The federally-funded Community Development Program offers a grant to those who qualify.

GENERAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Property must be located in the City of Wilkes-Barre.
- 2. Property must be an owner-occupied single family house.
- 3. Applicant must consent to a Housing Code Inspection.
- 4. Reside in a dwelling which contains a major housing code violation. determined to be of an **Emergency** nature.
- 5. Owner must have homeowners/fire insurance.
- 6. Owner must have flood insurance if within 100 year flood plain.
- 7. Property taxes must be current or be current with a repayment plan.
- 8. Total household income must not exceed the following income guidelines:

You may be eligible if your TOTAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME DOES NOT EXCEED the following limits:

ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE:

- 1. The total amount of assistance will be determined on a case by case basis depending on the cost to repair or replace the Emergency condition(s).
- 2. The repairs will be sub-contracted to a City of Wilkes-Barre licensed contractor.
- 3. All work will be inspected and approved by the City.
