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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE ZONING HEARING BOARD

A public hearing will be held in City Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, City Hall, 40 East Market Street, Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, 18701 on Wednesday, April 20, 2022 at 4:30 p.m., Daylight Savings Time, relative to the following zoning appeal applications:

- a) <u>Continued Hearing:</u> Pablo Zumba for the property located within an R-1 zone at 24-26 Cherry Street for a variance to construct a 50' x 13' storage building on a vacant lot and a variance to waive the rear yard setback from the required 25 feet down to 12 feet to construct the storage building.
- b) <u>Continued Hearing:</u> Shelter Management for the property located within a C-2 zone at 13 East South Street for a variance to waive the maximum allowable lot coverage within a C-2 zone from a 70% limit increased to 78 %, to construct a 60' x 75' two-story side addition on to the main building. A variance to waive 53 parking spaces including 1 handicap parking space for the proposed use.
- **c) Alan Klapat** for the property located within an R-1 zone at **78 Liddon Street** for a variance to waive one side yard setback from the required 5 feet down to 0 feet to construct a 12' x 24' attached carport on to the side of a home.
- **d) Edward Snarski** for the property located within an R-1 zone at **20 Burt Street** for a variance to waive the front yard setback from the required 25 feet down to 10 feet to construct a 48' x 42' L-shaped addition on to the front of the house.
- e) **DR Tire Service** for the property located within an C-1 zone at **89 North Washington Street** for a special exception to change a nonconforming use from a minor auto repair business change to a minor auto repair business with the retail sales of tires and the sales of preowned motor vehicles.

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f) WV Estates LLC for the property located within a R-1 zone at **20 Riverside Drive** for a special exception as a "Use Not Addressed Within Ordinance" to establish a firearms transfer business involving consignment sale of firearms to be transferred and /or picked up by the buyer.
