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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY OF WILKES-BARRE ZONING HEARING BOARD

A public hearing will be held in City Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, City Hall, 40 East Market Street, Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania, on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 at 4:30 p.m., Daylight Savings Time, relative to the following zoning appeal application:

- **a) Juana A. Vergara** for the property located within an R-1 zone at **104 North Fulton Street** for variances to waive the front yard setback form the required 25 feet down to 8 feet and to waive one side yard setback down from the required 5 feet down to 4 feet in order to construct a 4' x 7.5' deck with a roof on to the side of a home.
- **b)** La-Toya Wilson for the property located within an R-1 zone at **216 Horton Street** for a special exception home occupation daycare service for no more than five (5) children. A variance to waive two (2) parking spaces for the proposed use.
- c) Yunial Tavarez for the property located within an R-1 zone at 118 Grove Street for a special exception to establish a church with seating for 100 parishioners. A variance to waive thirteen (13) parking spaces including one handicap parking space for the proposed church use.
- d) Cross Valley Federal Credit Union for the property located at 34 Spring Street within both C-4 (24%) and R-1 (76%) zoning districts pursuant to section 310 of the Wilkes-Barre City Zoning Ordinance. A variance to construct a credit union building within an R-1 zone. A variance to install commercial antennae on a 25-foot-high pole within an R-1 zone. A variance to waive the front yard parking lot setback from the required 15 feet down to 5 feet and 4 feet respectively. A variance to waive the side yard parking setback from the required 15 feet down to 9 feet and 4 feet respectively. A variance to waive the landscaped planting strip requirement pertaining to screening. A variance to waive the maximum allowable driveway width from 20 feet increased to 26 feet.
